

- 8. After this parents went to meet the class-teachers, discussed about the academic performance of the students like class attendance, marks in class tests, internal marks and overall discipline in the campus.



- 2. The training placement department should try to place maximum students possible.



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
3. Given positive feedback for our facilities namely classroom, laboratory, canteen and other campus facilities also for teaching and non – teaching staff.

In all it was strong effort to bridge the communication gap between parents and teachers.


