The unit performed many activities like shramdan, awareness programs, wall paintings, construction and repairs, household surveys and hygiene awareness etc.

A seven day's residential Special Camp was jointly organized by Anantrao Pawar college of engineering and research and Anantrao Pawar college of Architecture at a village Aambed, Tal.-Velhe, Dist.- Pune, from 3rd Jan. 2020 to 10th Jan. 2020. Total 50 volunteers from both the colleges participated in this camp. The camp was organized with dual purpose of village development and personality development of the volunteers. Like every year, this year's camp also achieved appreciation from villagers and especially from the 'Gramsevak' and the Sarpanch, 'Grampanchayat Aambed'.

The salient Features of the camp are as follows:

- 1. Yoga, Surya Namaskar and morning walk.
- 2. Household Survey of the village.
- 3. Watershed Management project.
- 4. Shramadan for village development
- 5. Lectures on importance of blood and plasma donation.
- 6. Haripath.
- 7. Women Empowerment
- 8. Right to education

- 9. Zilha Parishad school development program.
- 10. Wall paintings on Social Awareness.
- Day started with yoga at 6:30 am to 7:30 am followed by breakfast and other refreshments. At 09 am all students started to reach their assigned sites at which shramdan was planned and one group used to prepare lunch and clean the residential area. Lunch at 2 pm followed by group activities till 5 pm and then refreshments. At 6 pm all volunteers join together for report writing and discussion for work done, difficulty faced and planning for next day's activity. Dinner at 9 followed by fun activities till 11pm.
 - On 3rd Jan 2020 all the volunteers reported at college campus and started the
 journey towards camp's place at Aambed, once reached to Aambed volunteers
 cleaned the campus and made arrangements for cooking and others facilities and
 survey was done for Watershed Management project, Shramadan sites, wall
 painting locations and village survey plan was finalized. In the evening official
 Inaugural ceremony was held in the presence of dignitaries from the village,
 college and invited guests.
 - On 4th Jan 2020, we started shramdan at famous Kalu Bai Temple. We clean all surrounding area of the temple by removing all the unwanted trees and making proper ground level around the temple.
 - On 5^{th Jan} 2020, to know the biodiversity in rural area we decided to go for trek around the ambed village and observed nearby environment, all the volunteers decided to climb the nearby hill area and made notes of the observation they found.
 - On 6th Jan 2020, to make awareness of cleanliness and promoting swachha bharat initiatives a rally was organized in Aambed village. During this rally women empowerment, cleanliness, Swachha-Bharat and right to education like social topics were highlighted and on same topic all the volunteers gave guidance to all the villagers during their survey work.
 - On 7th Jan 8th Jan 2020, during this period all the NSS volunteers constructed a small dam with a dedicated efforts of more than 50 volunteers for more than 2 days during morning session. All NSS volunteers were conducted household survey targeting many rural issues highlighted in Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, as a part of it our NSS volunteers filled the household survey form from each home where they visited and collected the detailed information of that respective family.
 - On 10th Jan 2020, Cleaning of the residential area and camp was ended with speeches of all the Programme Officers, faculty members and few social workers from village, followed by their felicitations program and after that some students sheared their experiences.

Village cleaning program, cleaning of Samaj Mandir area after every activity and School cleaning programs were conducted during the camp. The villagers were so happy with the activities that some of them came to the volunteers and appreciated in the work. This was a real encouragement and the credit goes to the sincere work of NSS volunteers only. Basic infrastructure development activities were conducted at the Primary School of the village. Informal talks with the villagers carried out to collect the Historical, Geographical & Socio-Cultural information of the village.

The success of the camp is attributed to the encouragement by all the organizing

authorities from Savitribai Phule Pune University, Department of National Service Scheme, Department of Student Development, Management council members, Principals, NSS POs and faculty members of all three colleges involved in this NSS Special Winter Camp, who motivated and blessed the our NSS volunteers.

Special Achievements:

- 1. The Sarpanch of the village was informed to organize some camps to attract high school is appreciated by the villagers that have shown them a **new way of rural employment.**
- 2. NSS volunteers created awareness among the villagers about personal hygiene and cleanliness, the problems caused due to improper garbage management. Also informed them the solutions to tackle these problems through easy methods like **Composting, incineration** etc.
- 3 With the help of sarpanch and active participation of villagers NSS volunteers carried out the activity of village cleaning throughout the village.
- 4 NSS volunteers carried out a new and practical program called as 'Kutumb Mitra' in which volunteers interact with various families regarding their family background, annual income, family tree diagram and problems which has been faced by them.
- 5 Volunteers conducted a rigorous survey of many houses and collected important information which will be useful for further development of Village. It was successful survey work in which maximum villagers were co-operated and discussed their issues with us.
