A brief introduction of the workshop and schedule of the workshop was delivered by Prof. Ramesh S. Lavhe, He mentioned the various aspects of hazardous situations and how the two day workshop should be made beneficial by students for themselves as well as the society and he mentioned that the students should make themselves mentally, physically and analytically stronger through such programs.

### Session-I

#### Lecture1: Mr. Milind Vaidya, Project Director, Disaster Management Cell, All India Institute of Local Self Government

Mr. Milind Vaidya discussed about an example situation and put the students through an imaginary drill wherein he made them analyze the real time precautions and remedial actions they should take to come out of the situation safely.

Example situation was “A building has caught fire, a situation has occurred, where numbers of people are fighting for escape.” Later he gave the TEN TIPS TO TACKLE (3T’s) to be kept in mind for a safe escape. He also focused on the work carried out by the NGO's in the field of disaster management.

## **Lecture 2: Mr. Vivek Naidu, Master Trainer, Disaster Mangement Cell, Collector Office, Pune**

Mr. Vivek Naidu spoke about routine scenario about LPG gas cylinder and its usage precautionary measures which should be kept in mind by every member in the house. He also discussed various case studies of the projects which are undertaken by govt. in the area of disaster management.
