 - Medication plants, fruit plants and environment friendly trees have been planted to clean the atmosphere.

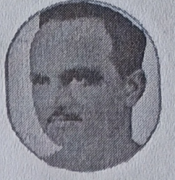

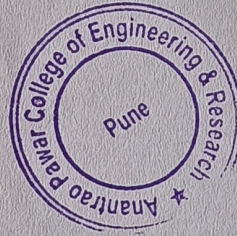
NOTICE
