Brief About Event: (Detail Program Description)

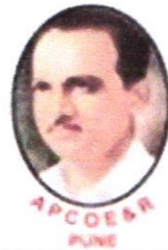
On **21st June 2025**, the **NSS Unit under Savitribai Phule Pune University**, in collaboration with the **Government of Maharashtra**, organized a spiritually enriching event titled "**Bhaktiyog Program**". The event took place in the early hours of the day, from **6:30 AM to 10:00 AM**, aiming to celebrate and promote the age-old traditions of devotion, discipline, and community harmony among the Warkari pilgrims and student volunteers.

Outcome of the Program:

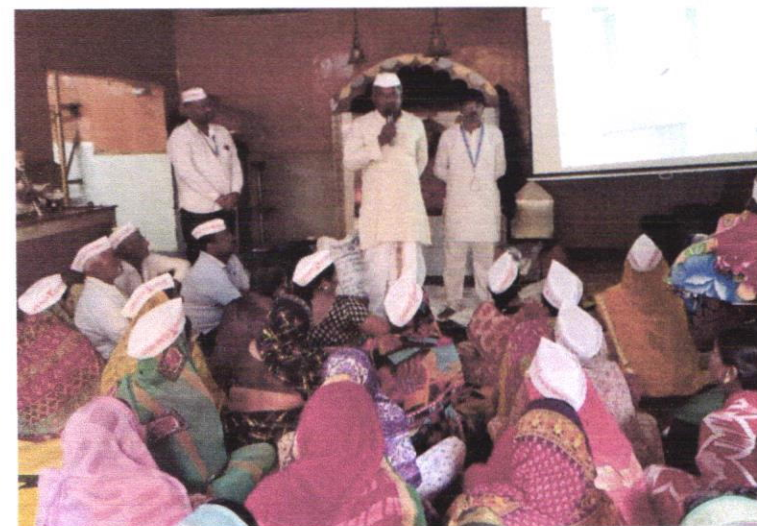
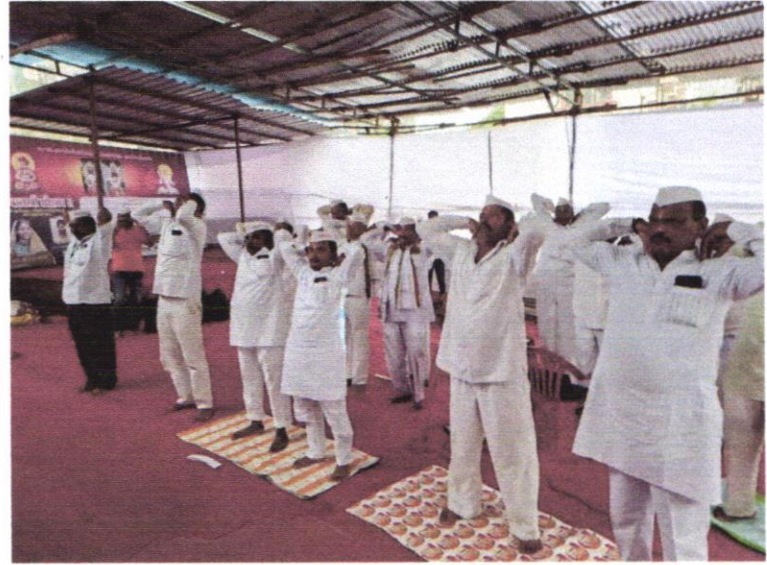
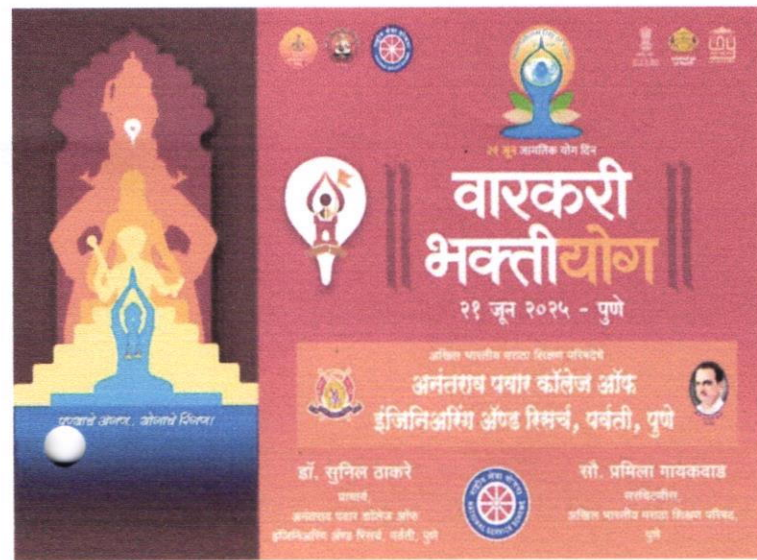

- **Digital Literacy:** Students explained safe digital transactions, UPI usage, and access to online government services to pilgrims.

- Reinforced the integration of cultural heritage with contemporary social causes like Swachh Bharat Abhiyan and Digital India.

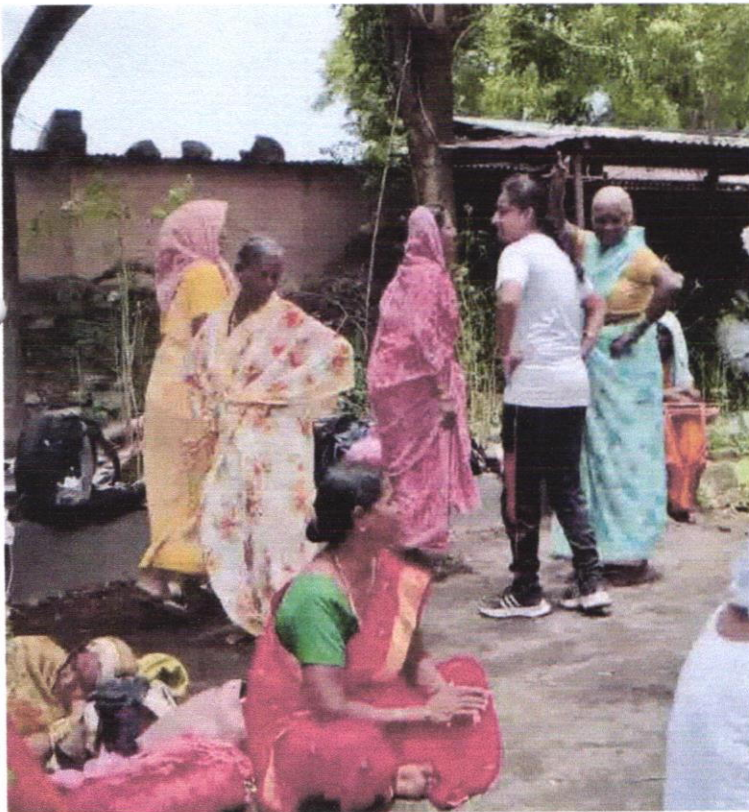
