He also shared insights into how students can convert their SIH projects into research papers or startup ideas.

Next, **Dr. Jitendra Musale**, Assistant Professor, Computer Department, elaborated on the **SIH problem statement selection process, evaluation criteria, and idea submission stages**. He explained how students can align their project ideas with national priorities and domain-specific challenges.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A segment, where students enthusiastically asked questions regarding idea generation, prototype development, and the benefits of participating in SIH. **Prof. Akash Dodke** summarized the session by encouraging students to collaborate across disciplines, form innovative teams, and register their ideas for SIH 2025.

Event Outcomes:


1. Students gained in-depth knowledge of **Smart India Hackathon 2025** structure and participation process.




Img. Dr. Jitendra Musale Giving idea about SIH




Img. Students attending IH Orientation Session


